

RIEGELMAN THIS IS PUBLIC HEALTH (TIPH) GLOBAL GRANT AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made on the 15 of May, 2025 between the **Escuela Andaluza de Salud Pública, Spain** hereinafter called the Grantee, and the Association of Schools and Programs of Public Health (**ASPPH**), which is a 501(c)(3) organization located in Washington, D.C. hereinafter called the Grantor, collectively known as the Parties.

Article I: Purpose of the Grant

The This is Public Health (TIPH) Campaign was launched in 2008 by the Association of Schools and Programs of Public Health (ASPPH) to raise awareness about the field of public health and the range of professions that are encompassed within the field.

The Riegelman TIPH Global Grant Program (TIPH Global) seeks to build on the success of the original TIPH campaign and increase the visibility of global public health.

The Grantee submitted a proposal to the Grantor and was selected as one of the winning proposals for the Riegelman TIPH Global Grant Program. The grant proposal included two parts: Part A, the project for which funds are awarded, and Part B, nomination of a student to be part of the TIPH Global Ambassadors program. This agreement pertains to Part A and associated budget, unless otherwise noted.

Article II: Period of the Grant Program

It is anticipated that the period of the grant for the Riegelman TIPH Global Grant Program shall run from May 15, 2025, through May 14, 2027. The disbursement of funds for the grant may be subject to delays not attributable to the Grantor.

Article III: Grant Amount and Resources

The Grantor shall provide the Grantee with the awarded funds and resources to execute the project, which shall include:

- The sum of **\$5,000 US Dollars (USD)**, subject to bank charges, fees and any other administrative charges not bearable by the Grantor;
- Digital images of the TIPH Global logo in multiple sizes and colors, in English (translations into local languages may be requested via the Supplemental Form noted in Article V); and
- TIPH Global Social Media Toolkit.

The grant is subject to the Grantee complying with all requirements of this Agreement, including but not limited to meeting the reporting requirements, as provided in paragraph VI. The grant is subject to ASPPH obtaining adequate funding from its sponsors and is subject to termination at the discretion of the Grantor at any time.

Article IV: Disbursement of Grant

Awarded funds shall be disbursed in three payments, as follows:

- 50% of the awarded funds, equivalent to **\$2,500 USD**, once this Agreement is signed and required Supplement Forms are submitted;
- 25% of the awarded funds, **\$1,250 USD**, upon receipt of the Progress Report showing progress toward the project's goals, after December 5, 2025; and
- The remaining 25%, **\$1,250 USD**, upon receipt of the Mid-term Report showing progress toward the project's goals, after May 29, 2026.

Article V: Supplemental Forms and Addendums

The Grantee must provide to the Grantor the following Supplemental Forms:

- Wire Transfer Information (required)
- Project Description and Contacts (required)
- TIPH Language Translation Request (optional)

Any addendum to this agreement is considered part of the agreement, including but not limited to:

- Letter of Award for Riegelman TIPH Global Grant Program
- TIPH Global Social Media Toolkit

Article VI: Reporting Requirements

The Grantee is required to submit to the Grantor the following reports and products:

- Progress Report, covering progress toward achievement of project goals and summary of expenses (from award and matching funds), for the period of May 15 – November 14, 2025 – deadline December 5, 2025
- Mid-term Report, covering progress toward achievement of project goals and summary of expenses (from award and matching funds), for the period of May 15, 2025 – May 14, 2026 – deadline May 29, 2026
- Progress Report, covering progress toward achievement of project goals and summary of expenses (from award and matching funds), for the period of May 15, 2026 – November 14, 2026 – deadline December 4, 2026
- Final Project Showcase, to exhibit the outcomes of the Awardee's project – deadline April 30, 2027
- Final Report, covering progress toward achievement of project goals and summary of expenses (from award and matching funds), for the period of May 15, 2025-May 14, 2027 – deadline May 28, 2027
- Final Evaluation, an assessment of the Riegelman TIPH Global Grant Program – deadline June 4, 2027

The Grantor may request that the Grantee provide updates on the progress of their project at any time beyond the reporting requirements described above. In the event that Grantee fails to meeting the reporting requirements, the Grantor may terminate the grant at its option.

Article VII: Intellectual Property

The Parties agree that This Is Public Health® (TIPH) logo is a registered trademark of the Association of Schools and Programs of Public Health. The Grantor hereby grants the Grantee a non-exclusive license to use the TIPH logo for purposes of this agreement only. Grantee agrees not to license, sell, or otherwise transfer the TIPH logo to a third party without the express written consent of ASPPH.

Details around proper usage of the TIPH Global logo and other This Is Public Health branding can be found [online](#) and in the TIPH Global Toolkit. The Grantee is required to follow these guidelines on proper usage. Grantor retains the right to deny Grantee use of the TIPH logo due to failure to abide by this agreement and/or trademark usage and branding guidelines.

The Parties agree that the Grantee is the owner of any intellectual property developed during the Riegelman TIPH Global Grant Program, which shall include, but are not limited to, print or digital materials, video or audio recordings, and training manuals. The Grantee is required to provide copies of all developed products to the Grantor and hereby grants the Grantor non-exclusive license to use intellectual property developed with this grant. The Grantor shall make proper attribution to the Grantee when using and promoting Grantee's intellectual property.

Each party agrees that it will not infringe upon the intellectual property of the other party, and shall not use any trademark, copyright, patent, license or other intellectual property of the other party without the written consent of the other party.

Article VIII: Resolution of Disputes

The Parties agree that all disputes arising under this agreement shall be resolved by mediation and/or arbitration. Each party waives their legal rights to sue the other party in any federal or state court for any damages, except for seeking injunctive relief to prevent the other party from infringing upon its intellectual property. The prevailing party is entitled to recover attorney fees and costs from the other party in the event that litigation is necessary to protect the party's intellectual property.

Article IX: Other Terms

The Grantee is eligible for the Riegelman TIPH Global Grant Program through its membership to ASPHER which is a member of the Global Network for Academic Public Health. Grantee agrees to maintain its membership with [insert Association name] during the term of this agreement.

The Grantee is part of a cohort of projects supported by Riegelman TIPH Global Grant Program. The Grantee may have access to an Online Community, which may be used to communicate with others in the cohort for the duration of this agreement. Grantee agrees not to disparage the Grantor or other grant recipients in the Online Community.

Except as otherwise provided, this Agreement may be amended in writing by mutual agreement of the parties. All amendments and modifications must be in writing and signed by both the parties. This Agreement may not be assigned by either party without the prior written consent of the other party.

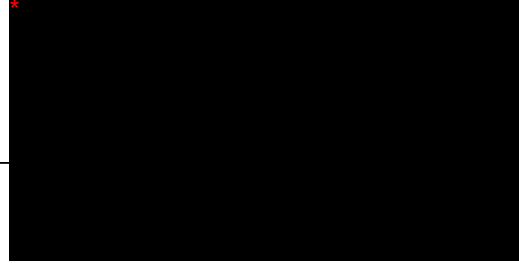
